Family Brunch & Tribute to Mary:

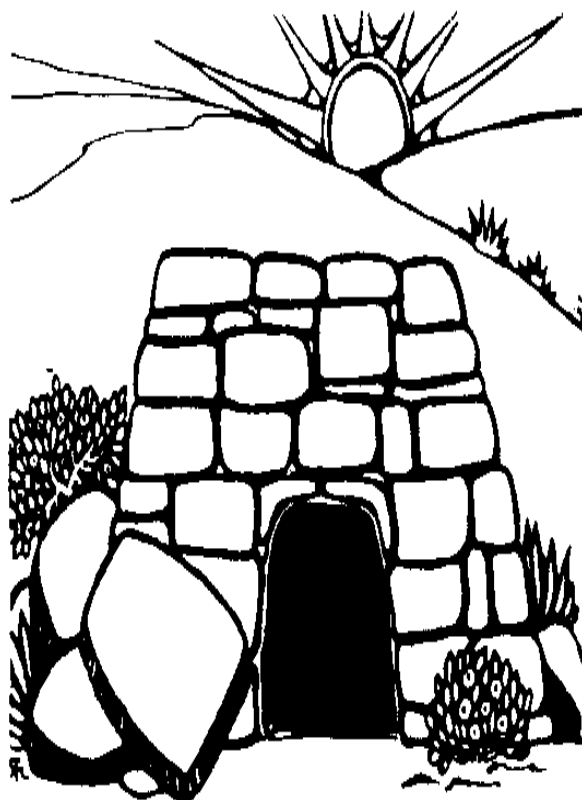
